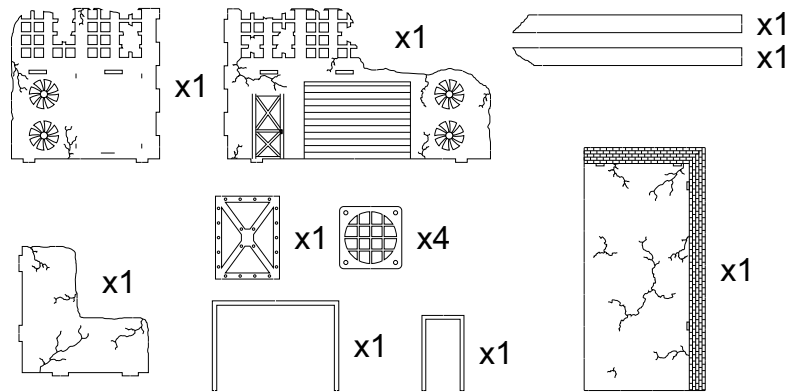
You will need:

- .Wood Glue
- .Craft Knife
- .Sandpaper

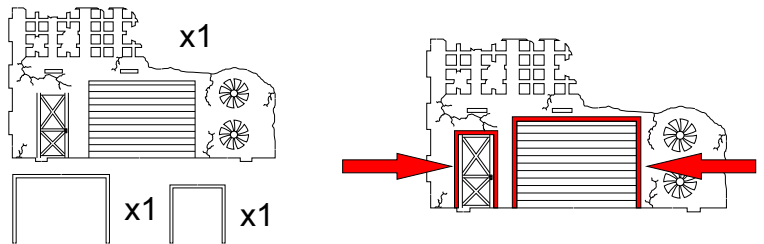
How To Build: Small WTC Ruin

Always test fit pieces before applying any glue. Lightly sand the places where you wish to apply glue, this helps to create a stronger bond between the two surfaces. Always use a strong wood glue, craft pva glue is not recommended.

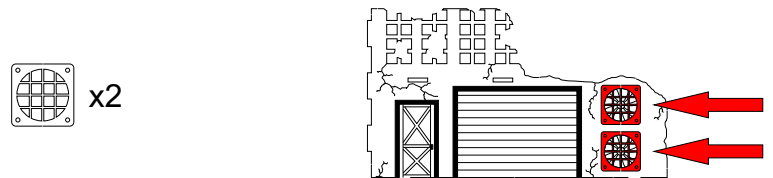
1. Carefully remove all the pieces from the sprue, being extra careful on the smaller, more delicate parts. We recommend cutting the tabs with a sharp craft knife to prevent any accidental damage.



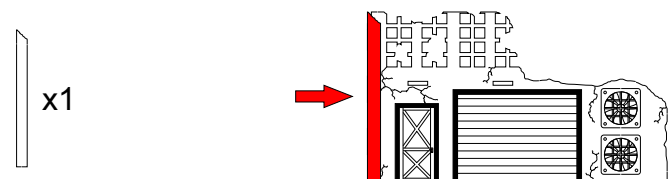
2. Take the front wall and the two door frames, and glue them in place as shown, making sure they do not overhang the bottom edge



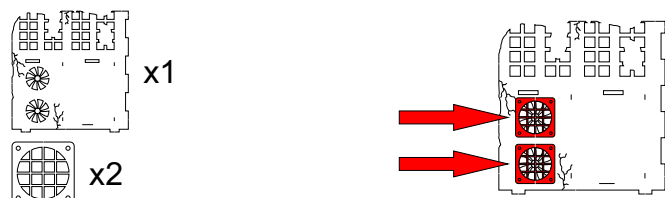
3. Take two of the vent covers, and glue them in place as shown.



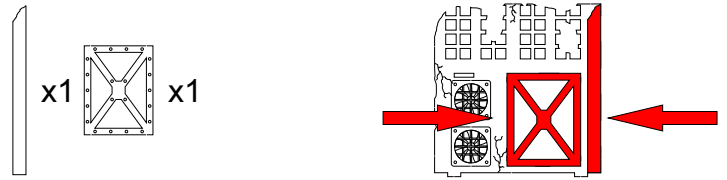
4. Now add the vertical strip. The top of the strip should slope away from the corner of the wall. Make sure to remove any glue from the corner tabs/floor slots



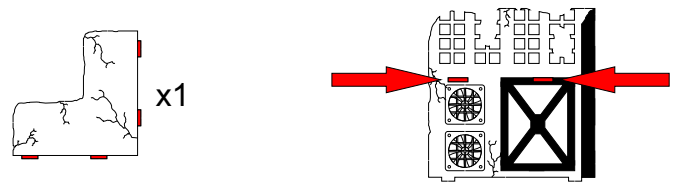
5. Now take the short side, and the last two vent covers, and glue them in place as shown.



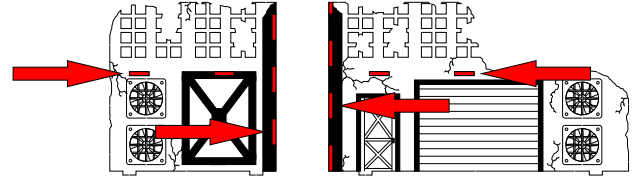
5. Now take the x-panel and the vertical strip, and glue them in place as shown. You should see some guidelines, which will help position the x-panel. Make sure to remove any glue from the corner tabs and floor slots



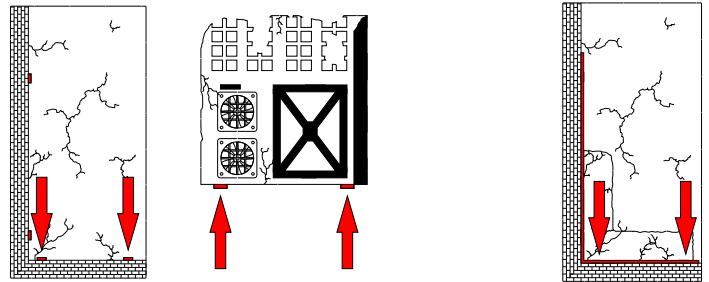
6. Now take the floor piece, and slot it into the side wall piece. This should be a nice, tight fit, so you do not have to glue this piece if you do not want to. This allows the pieces to be stored away flat



7. Now slot the front wall piece into place, joining it to the side wall using the corner tabs, and to the floors using the floor slots



8. Now slot the finished building into the base piece



9. Your WTC ruin is now complete
