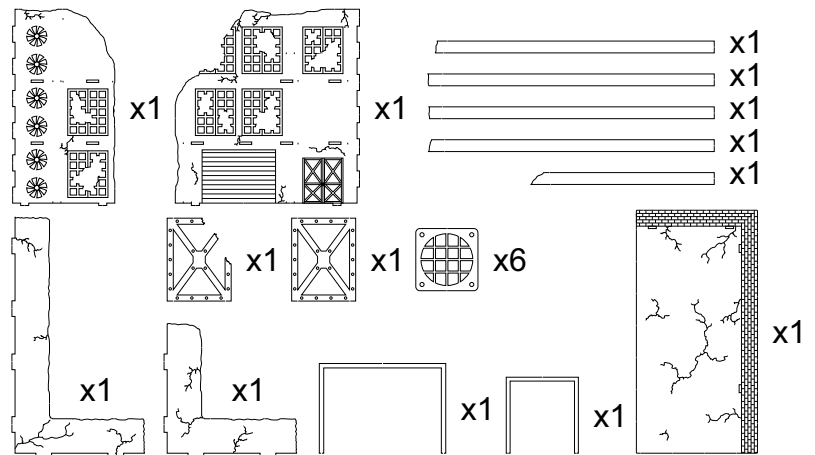
You will need:

- .Wood Glue
- .Craft Knife
- .Sandpaper

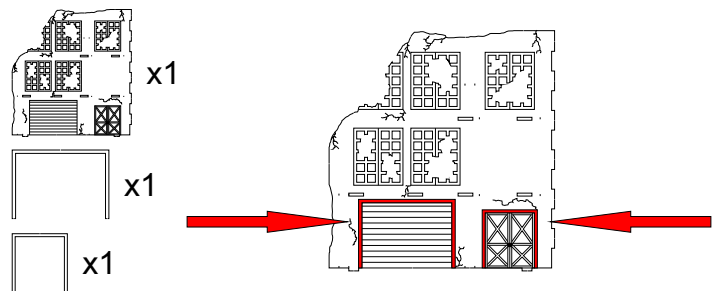
## How To Build: Large WTC Ruin

Always test fit pieces before applying any glue. Lightly sand the places where you wish to apply glue, this helps to create a stronger bond between the two surfaces. Always use a strong wood glue, craft pva glue is not recommended.

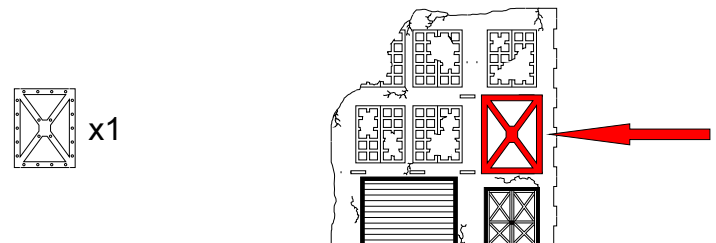
1. Carefully remove all the pieces from the sprue, being extra careful on the smaller, more delicate parts. We recommend cutting the tabs with a sharp craft knife to prevent any accidental damage.



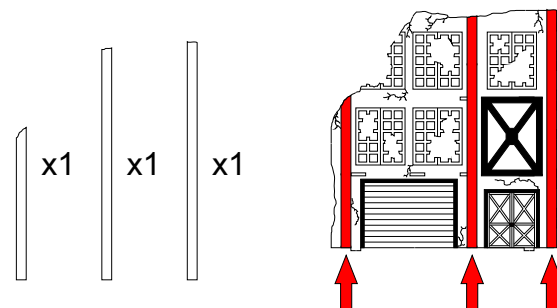
2. Take the front wall and the two door frames, and glue them in place as shown, making sure they do not overhang the bottom edge



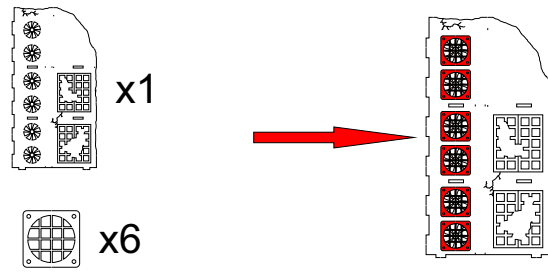
3. Take the full panel piece, and glue it in place as shown. You should see some guidelines on the wall above the door, which will help with aligning the piece. Make sure to remove any glue that goes into the floor slots



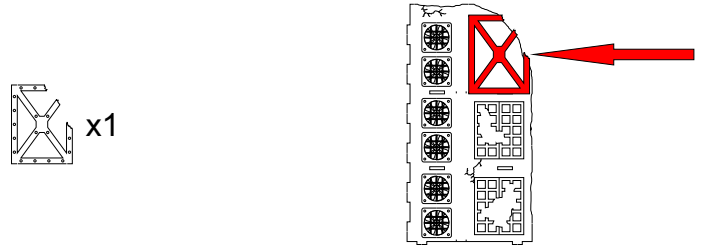
4. Now add the vertical strips. Test fit all of them BEFORE glueing them, to make sure you use the correct piece. The tops of the strips should follow the shape of the wall. There are also guidelines on the wall, to help with the alignment of the strips. Make sure to remove any glue from the corner tabs/floor slots



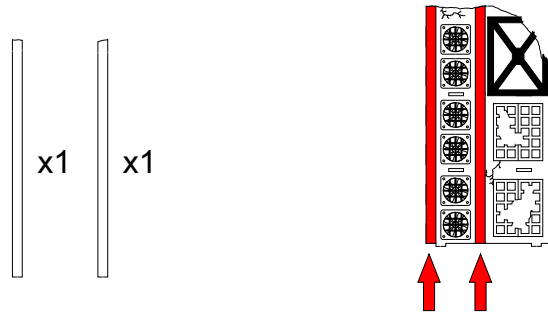
5. Now take the side wall and the six vent covers, and glue them in place as shown



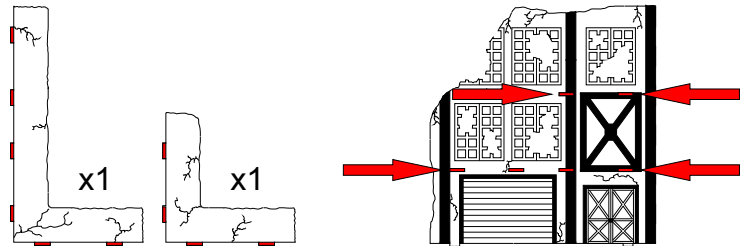
6. Now glue the broken panel in place, making sure to remove any glue that goes into the floor slots



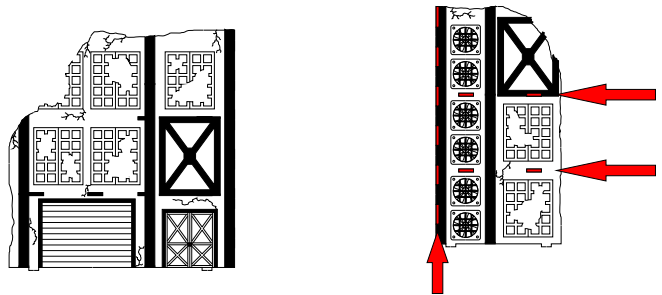
7. Now add the last two vertical strips. Test fit them again to make sure you use the correct piece. There are more guidelines on the wall for these pieces. Make sure to remove any glue that goes into the corner tabs/floor slots



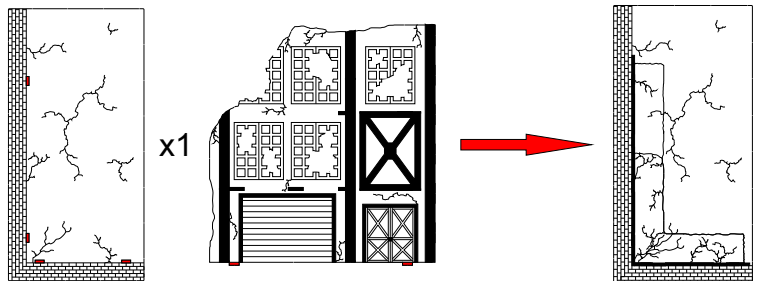
8. Now take the two floor pieces, and slot them into the front wall piece. These should be a nice, tight fit, so you do not have to glue these pieces if you do not want to. This allows the pieces to be stored away flat



9. Now slot the side wall piece into place, joining it to the front wall using the corner tabs, and to the floors using the floor slots



10. Now slot the finished building into the base piece



11. Your WTC ruin is now complete
